Apply for a Majalla Part Time Internship

The Majalla Magazine is looking for two candidates to begin a 6 month internship project starting February 1st and July 1st. Candidates should be pursuing an undergraduate degree in Economics, Middle East Studies, International Relations, Political Science or another relevant discipline to The Majalla magazine profile. We are particularly looking for candidates with an excellent academic record and with a strong interest in a future career in academia, journalism, or policy making.

Interns will participate in all of The Majalla's editorial work and will undergo training designed to help them further develop their career interests. To this end, the selection process will include personal interviews. Once selected, The Majalla editorial team will tailor the responsibilities of the interns to their interests so as to encourage their professional development and provide them with a valuable experience. Interns will work under the direct supervision of an editor, and assist them with research and general editorial work.

Interns should have excellent writing skills, strong attention to detail, and should be fluent in English.

This internship is an unpaid project, not an employment. However, a weekly stipend for transportation and lunch will be provided.
