### **What entry level roles do you have?**

"We have opportunities for Water and sanitation engineers, nutritionists, nurses, logistics roles and finance. For our food security programmes we would expect people to have an agricultural degree and relevant qualifications for other roles."

### **Without that technical background do generalists have a chance?**

"It's true that our overseas operations do not have the slack to take on people without specific technical skills. However, the training route for logistician could be a 9 month diploma course - its not a professional qualification as with engineering or medicine but it is a specialist post that is required on the field to help with the smooth running of our programmes

### **Do you take volunteers on in your London office?**

Yes, at any one time we might have up to six volunteers. They help our two full time staff across a range of projects. Communications, fundraising, finance, and HR.
